



A personalized crop quality report at no cost to you!

When you sign up for the Harvest Sample Program, you'll get grade and quality information annually on samples from your crop of barley, beans, canary seed, canola, chickpeas, corn, flaxseed, lentils, mustard, oats, pea beans, peas, soybeans, rye and wheat.

Grade, dockage and quality results

For each sample, our inspectors provide unofficial grade and quality results at no charge, including:

- Falling Number for wheat and rye
- vomitoxin (deoxynivalenol or DON) levels for wheat, corn and barley
- protein content for cereal grains and pulses
- oil, protein and chlorophyll content for canola
- oil and protein content and iodine value for flaxseed
- oil and protein for mustard seed and soybeans

Note: Grades are unofficial because the samples are not collected by a Canadian Grain Commission grain inspector.

Easy to sign up and send samples

1. Sign up online at grainscanada.gc.ca/hsp.
2. Before harvest, we send you a kit, including your Harvest Sample identification number and postage-paid envelopes.
3. Fill the envelopes with representative samples of your grain and mail them back to us.
4. We assess your samples.
5. We send your results to you by email. You can also get your results online or by calling us.

5 great reasons to participate



1. There is **no cost to sign up**, and the sample envelopes are postage-paid.
2. You will **know your grain's grade and dockage**, based on the samples you submit.
3. We publish reports on the quality of the crop, based on scientific analyses of producers' harvest samples. These reports help marketers **promote domestic and international sales of Canadian grain**.
4. We use your samples to **establish and evaluate the effectiveness of grading factors** and to determine if grain standards need to be changed.
5. Our scientists use your samples in their research on **grain quality and grain safety issues**, which supports Canada's reputation as a reliable source of high-quality grain.
